Visit them while the sun shines. David Gryn, who has directed Artprojx events and film screenings at the Prince Charles Cinema over the past five years, opens a new gallery space in Knightsbridge. The gallery will open with a group exhibition 'Dadadandy Boutique' (May 8-31) that aims to create the 'ultimate shopping experience'. The exhibition will feature works by Piero Golia, David Hammons, Joe Scanlan and John Stezaker alongside collaborative work of Simon Moretti and former London gallerist Paul Heber-Percy. Their work lends the show its name. A film club will also be held at Artprojx Space, and Gryn also plans to continue and develop off-site projects, including future screenings to be held at Tate Britain.
