

● **Dadadandy Boutique** London

I have been meaning to write about Dadadandy – the art brand for the post postmodern age – for some time, but somehow the chance has eluded me. Anyway, this preview should redress the balance. Dadadandy was named after a collage by the dadaist Hannah Hoch and is run by artist Simon Moretti and curator Paul Heber-Percy. Essentially they are everything

and nothing: a high art shopping experience, an exhibition, a forum, a production company, able to regenerate themselves faster than Doctor Who. This is their first exhibition in the new Artprojx Space and has work by the stunning cosmic Brazilian artist Assume Vivid Astro Focus – the closest thing you'll ever get to 1967 in the 21st



century. Also on show are installations by Goshka Macuga and a selection of sculpture pieces by Francis Upritchard (work pictured). **IL**
